FOLLOW THE LAW

When Sharing the Road

- Ride in the same direction as motor vehicles
- Ride as close as practical to the right-hand curb
- Signal all turns and lane changes with your arm
- Pass cars on the left
- Ride no more than 2 abreast

When Using a Sidewalk

- Give the right-of-way to pedestrians
- Give an audible signal before passing pedestrians

Wherever You Are

- Do not impede traffic
- Use lights and reflectors at night

KNOW WHAT TO DO

At an Accident Scene

- Call 911; any accident you are in should have a police report
- Take pictures and/or video of you, your bike and your surroundings
- Get the contact info of the driver and all witnesses
- Seek medical attention even if you believe your injuries are minor

After an Accident

- Call your insurance company to report your accident
- Write down what happened as soon as possible
- Don't fix your bike or do anything with your gear/clothing
- Call a lawyer if you think you may need to file a property damage or injury claim
